

Sugarcreek Village Council had a Regular Council Meeting on Monday July 17, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. in council chambers with Mayor Clayton Weller presiding.

Visitors: Bill Theiss, Doug Frautschy, Michael Beachy, Dan Yoder, Michael Hammond, Barb Limbacher, Scott Goodman, and Bev Keller.

Roll Call: Paul Alderfer, Sam Beachy (absent), Mick Fanning, Arlen Hostetler, Jeff Schrock, and Linda Wilson.

Minutes: The Mayor asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes. There were none so the minutes stood as typed.

Expenditures: Schrock asked about the repairs to the IGA generator repair. Administrator Bill Theiss said it was the lift station by the IGA that was struck by lightning. Hostetler made a motion to pay list of bills submitted by the Fiscal/Officer, second by Wilson. Vote recorded: Yea 5, Motion carried.

Mayor: Mayor Clayton Weller along with Chief Kaser marked the streets that will be closed for events that those working can drive golf carts on. (See Attached) The Solicitor will draw up an Ordinance to be voted on by Council for events such as Swiss Festival, 50's Fling, Soap Box Derby, and unnamed events. Arts On Broadway would like to use the square for an Art Walk on October 14th from 12:00 until 5:00. Hostetler made a motion to permit this event, second by Schrock. Vote recorded: Yea 5, Motion carried. It was announced that there will be fireworks on August 15th, and the Police and Fire Departments have been informed.

Donation to Fire Department: The Mayor presented a check to the Fire Department from a donation of \$190.00, from the class of 1959 in memory of classmates that have passed. They took up this donation in Memory of Dave Shutt.

Mayor Weller wanted to thank the Water/Street Departments for their hard work last week on the Water Break at Main Street, and 2017 Paving Project.

Administrator: Bill Theiss informed the Council that Western Branch Diesel was in the Village to do maintenance on the generators. They found coolant in the pump at the backup generator at the Water Plant. The cost to repair this will be no more than \$5,650.29. Fanning made a motion to have the repairs done, second by Wilson. Vote recorded: Yea 5, Motion carried. EPA reported a low bank test on generator at the Waste Water Plant, and Theiss is still waiting on parts for the IGA lift station. Last Theiss said that he is getting quotes for the generator at the Fire Station.

Fire: Michael Beachy and Dan Yoder wanted to thank the Council for all their support, and all the repairs being done at the station.

Paul Alderfer said that he wanted to thank the class of 1959 for their donation to the Fire Department. All Council agreed that the Black Top this year looks nice. Schrock would like to see 2 more benches located at the Clock over town, and will get with the Mayor and show him where he feels they could be placed.

Ordinance #17-2198 Titled: ADOPTING REVISIONS TO THE ZONING CODE AND SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF SUGARCREEK, OHIO was read for the fourth time. Alderfer made a motion to adopt Ordinance #17-2198, second by Schrock. Vote recorded: Yea 5, Motion carried.

Ordinance #17-2200 Titled: CLARIFYING, UPDATING, AND ADOPTING EMPLOYMENT POLICIES FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SUGARCREEK, OHIO was read for the second time.

Ordinance #17-2201 Titled: AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2017 TUSCARAWAS COUNTY LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN was read for the first time. Schrock made a motion to suspend the rules that requires an Ordinance to be read on three different days, second by Wilson. Vote recorded: Yea 5, Motion carried. Hostetler made a motion to adopt Ordinance #17-2201 as an emergency, second by Alderfer. Vote recorded: Yea 5, Motion carried.

Having no further business Hostetler made a motion to adjourn.
