

Sugarcreek Village Council had a Regular Council Meeting on Monday March 20, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. in council chambers with Mayor Clayton Weller presiding.

Visitors: Chief Kaser, Bill Theiss, Michael Hammond, Barb Limbacher, and Doug Frautschy.

Roll Call: Linda Wilson, Paul Alderfer, Sam Beachy, Mick Fanning, Arlen Hostetler, and Jeff Schrock.

Minutes: The Mayor asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes. There were none so the minutes stood as typed.

Expenditures: Fanning made a motion to pay list of bills submitted by the Fiscal/Officer, second by Beachy. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.

Mayor: Mayor Clayton Weller said that the Businessmen asked him if the Village had any spots where they could display some of their awards. Mayor Weller said that we have two shelving units that he has checked into getting glass for, and the total cost would be \$420.00. Mayor Weller would like for Council to approve letting them use half of the unit, and the Village would use the other half. With being said, we then would only pay for half of the glass. Hostetler made a motion to let the Businessmen use half of the shelving unit, and then just pay for half of the glass, second by Schrock. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.

Purchase Property from Garaway School: Mayor Weller said that the Village was interested in purchasing some property from the School, for the New Booster Station at Miller Avenue. The school is willing to sell the property for \$3,500.00. Council will vote on this matter, when the Solicitor has everything in place, and an Ordinance drawn up for the purchase.

Mayor Weller informed all Council Members to remember to keep all committee books updated when they have any meetings. Tree City will be held in Loudonville this year, at a charge of \$25.00 per person. The Mayor would like for three people to attend this year. Alderfer made a motion to permit three to attend, second by Wilson. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried. Mayor Weller said that the office is getting more calls for different situations on renting the Grove, and have no rules to go by for these. He will be turning this over to the Lands, Buildings, and Sidewalks, Committee.

Mayor Clayton Weller would like to appoint Jeremy Lampley to the Police Department as Patrol I Full-Time Position. Hostetler made a motion to confirm the hiring of Jeremy Lampley, second by Beachy. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.

Events Held on Streets or Property: Mayor Weller would like for council to approve the different events listed to be held in the Village of Sugarcreek. STEM Race May 7th, Soap Box Rally May 20th, 21st, 50's Fling June 9th and 10th, Soap Box Derby June 24th and 25th, Greco Band July 22nd, Run for Gnome Aug 5th with Fireworks, Businessmen's Auction Aug 8th, Swiss Festival Sept 29th and 30th, Light Up Sugarcreek Dec 2nd, and Frost Fest February 18th. Schrock made a motion to permit the events to happen, second by Wilson. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.

Streets, Water, and Sewer: Linda Wilson brought the totals for the Paving for 2017 to the Council for a total of \$332,000.00, so we can get bids from the County. Schrock made a motion to approve the Paving totals for 2017, second by Beachy. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.

Lands, Buildings, and Sidewalks: Sam Beachy informed the Council that his next committee meeting will be April 3rd, at 6:30 p.m.

Personnel, Economic Development: Jeff Schrock reported that the handbook is now finished with the changes made, and was given to the Solicitor to make the changes, and also modify the Ordinance we now have in place concerning this matter.

Ordinance #17-2191 Titled: VACATING A PORTION OF YODER AVENUE IN THE VILLAGE OF SUGARCREEK, OHIO was read for the second time.

Ordinance #17-2192 Titled: AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF SUGARCREEK, OHIO TO SELL A 2011 DODGE CHARGER POLICE CAR was read for the second time.

Having no further business Hostetler made a motion to adjourn.
