

Sugarcreek Village Council had a Regular Council Meeting on Monday May 1, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. in council chambers with Mayor Clayton Weller presiding.

Visitors: Bill Theiss, and Bev Keller.

Roll Call: Mick Fanning, Arlen Hostetler, Jeff Schrock, Linda Wilson, Paul Alderfer, and Sam Beachy.

Minutes: The Mayor asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes. There were none so the minutes stood as typed.

Expenditures: Hostetler made a motion to pay list of bills submitted by the Fiscal/Officer, second by Schrock. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.

Mayor: Mayor Clayton Weller informed the Council that he would like for them to vote to have an Ordinance drawn up for the next meeting, and have it passed before May 22, 2017, to allow ODOT to resurface State Route 39, thru the Village.
