

Sugarcreek Village Council had a Regular Council Meeting on Monday September 18, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. in council chambers with Mayor Clayton Weller presiding.

Visitors: Doug Frautschy, Chief Miller, Cody Shelter, Barb Limbacher, John Meek, Lloyd Crilow, Bill Theiss, and Bev Keller.

Roll Call: Arlen Hostetler, Jeff Schrock, Linda Wilson, Paul Alderfer, Sam Beachy, and Mick Fanning.

Minutes: The Mayor asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes. There were none so the minutes stood as typed.

Expenditures: Jeff Schrock said that the Revenue looks good for the year. Schrock made a motion to pay list of bills submitted by the Fiscal/Officer, second by Wilson. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.

Mayor: Mayor Clayton Weller said that the Sugarcreek Township would like to meet with the Village Mayor, Fire Chief, and Auburn Township Trustees on October 19th at 6:00, in the Fire Station. The Mayor and Chief would like for the Council Members to attend. Mayor Weller said that the Miller Avenue Project is going well, and the new Pump Station is to come in this Wednesday, but they will not be switching over until after the Swiss Festival is over, in case there are any issues. Mayor Weller would also like to thank the residents in that area for their patients during the installation of the Miller Avenue Booster Station.

Village Administrator: Bill Theiss informed the Council Members that he had been looking into repairing the generator at the Water Plant. The repairs would have cost around \$7,000.00, and after looking into this further, his recommendation is to purchase a new one for \$26,750.00, from Millersburg Electric. Wilson made a motion to purchase the new generator, second by Fanning. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried. Bill Theiss also reported on the 39/Edelweiss project, stating the all the Utilities have been contacted, but we now are waiting on the respond from the rail road.

Fire: Chief Kevin Miller said that the new Fire Truck will be done October 23, 2017, and picked up some the first week in November. Chief Miller is also getting prices for a new Ambulance.

Streets, Water, & Sewer: Linda Wilson would like to call for a committee meeting on October 2nd, at 6:45 to discuss the new 2018 water and sewer rates.

Personnel, Economic Development: Jeff Schrock would like to call for a committee meeting on October 2nd, at 6:00, to discuss the pay scale for 2018. Schrock said that they should be thinking about if they are raising the Council Members salary, since they can only get the raise the year of election. A comment was made that Solicitor Frautschy's office looks very nice on the outside, and the sidewalks up at the Miller Avenue Booster Station.

Ordinance #17-2205 Titled: AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FISCAL/OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF SUGARCREEK, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH REGIONAL COLLECTION SERVICES, INC., FOR PROVIDING EMS COLLECTION SERVICES FOR THE SUGARCREEK FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY was read for the third time. Hostetler made a motion to remove this Ordinance from consideration, second by Schrock. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.

Ordinance #17-2207 Titled: CHANGING THE ZONING OF THE ZAHNER PROPERTIES IN THE VILLAGE OF SUGARCREEK, OHIO FROM R-1 TO B-2 first reading. Mayor Clayton Weller said that there will be a Public Hearing on October 16th, at 6:45 about this Ordinance.

Having no further business Hostetler made a motion to adjourn.
