

Sugarcreek Village Council had a Regular Council Meeting on Monday January 8, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in council chambers with Mayor Clayton Weller presiding.

Visitors: Chief Kaser, Bev Keller, John Meek, and Sam Beachy.

Roll Call: Jeff Schrock, Linda Wilson, Paul Alderfer, Lloyd Crilow, Mick Fanning (Absent), and Jason Hamsher.

Minutes: The Mayor asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes. There were none so the minutes stood as typed.

Expenditures: Schrock made a motion to pay list of bills submitted by the Fiscal/Officer, second by Wilson. Vote recorded: Yea 5, Motion carried.

Mayor: Mayor Clayton Weller welcomed the new Council Members. Mayor Weller reported that the Water Department had 4 breaks in the last couple weeks. There was a big leak on Main Street, in the downtown area, and they will be finishing this up Wednesday night at 9:00 p.m., to avoid shutting off any business during their working hours.
