

Sugarcreek Village Council had a Meeting on Monday January 22, 2020, with Mayor Jeff Stutzman presiding.

Visitors: Doug Frautschy, and Chief Kevin Kaser.

Roll Call: Ron Atkinson, Sam Beachy, Mick Fanning, Jason Hamsher, Clayton Weller, and Paul Alderfer.

Minutes: The Mayor asked if there were any corrections to the minutes from the Regular Council Meeting. Fiscal/Officer said that the dates the Mayor were in correct. Atkinson made a motion to accept the minutes with the one correction, second by Beachy. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.

Expenditures: Weller made a motion to pay the list of bills submitted by the Fiscal/Officer, second by Beachy. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.

Mayor: Mayor Stutzman wants to appoint Natasha Dowdle as a Patrolman 1. Weller made a motion to hire Dowdle to Patrolman 1, second by Atkinson. Vote recorded 6, Motion carried.

Solicitor: Solicitor Frautschy said that if council passes the easement ordinance tonight as an emergency, he will sign the easement. Frautschy said that he will be in Cuba from January 28th until February 4th, 2020.

Village Administrator: Matt Specht reported that the street department will be picking up Christmas trees starting every Monday, with the last day being Friday January 31st. They also will be doing some repairs and updates at the Grove, and Cherry Ridge Park. The Water Department will be working with the Fire Department on repairs to fire hydrants.

Fire Department: Assistant Fire Chief John Meek reported that the Fire Department will be having an auction on February 1st. Meek said that he has been working with the Water Superintendent Jobe Stutzman and the repairs to the fire hydrants.

Police: Chief Kaser said the officer McKelvey had a car go through town at a high rate of speed. McKelvey took off after the vehicle, which wrecked a couple of times, but was stopped. Chief Kaser said that he ended up out of town, so the Ohio State Patrol took over at that point. Our officer along with the K-9, and cruiser were fine with no injury.

Councilmember Paul Alderfer announced he will be moving out of town but will let everyone know when it becomes closer to the actual date.

Atkinson made a motion to suspend the rules that requires an ordinance to be read on three different days, second by Hamsher. Vote recorded 6, Motion carried. Weller made a motion to pass Ordinance #20-2269 as an emergency, second by Atkinson. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.
