November 16, 2020

Sugarcreek Village Council had a regular council meeting via Zoom Monday November 16, 2020, with Mayor Jeff Stutzman presiding.

Visitors: Chief Kevin Kaser, Christine Quickel, Doug Frautschy, Barb Limbacher, and Matt Specht.

Roll Call: Matt Miller, Ron Atkinson, Sam Beachy, Mick Fanning - absent, Jason Hamsher, and Josh Jarvis.

A motion was made by Jason Hamsher and seconded by Matt Miller to accept the minutes as typed by the Fiscal/Office. At roll call all present members voted approval.

Matt Miller made a motion to accept the expenditures for the first two weeks of November. The motion was seconded by Ron Atkinson. At roll call all present members voted approval.

Mayor Stutzman announced that Becky Crilow is now working from home as a consultant while Connie Bowen is working as the Fiscal Officer in Village Hall. He explained that Bowen should be hired as the Fiscal officer so that she can conduct business with the county. Hamsher made a motion to approve Bowen as Fiscal Officer for the Village of Sugarcreek, seconded by Sam Beachy. At roll call all present members voted approval.

Mayor Stutzman explained that Crilow is available for consulting through April 1, 2020. As such her wage should remain the same even though her title has changed. After discussion Jason Hamsher made a motion to keep Crilow's wage the same, seconded by Sam Beachy. At roll call 4 members voted approval, Ron Atkinson abstained from voting.

Solicitor Doug Frautschy announced that per Ordinance number 20-2287, the street vacation of a portion of Second Street is complete.

Police Chief Keven Kaser announced that the new 2020 Ford Explorer which will be built out for the K-9 arrived on November 13, 2020.

Safety Chairman, Ron Atkinson said the Safety meeting which was canceled will be scheduled at a future date.

Communications, Public relations, and Refuse Chairman, Josh Jarvis noted that he has been in contact with the Kimble Company for the upcoming renewal and will have a meeting with them within the next two weeks. The contract is for trash and recycling service in the Village.

Economic Development, Parks and Recreation chairman Matt Miller wanted to note that in the previous meeting a stop bar was requested at the new turn lane on St Rt 93.
