

Sugarcreek Village Council had a regular council meeting at Village Hall June 6, 2022, with Mayor Jeff Stutzman presiding.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Visitors: Matt Specht, Police Chief Kevin Kaser, Jeff Levengood, Jeff Stearns, Mike Hammond

Roll Call: Sam Beachy, Mick Fanning - absent, Jason Hamsher, Josh Jarvis, Jim Parson - absent, Matt Miller.

Sam Beachy made a motion to accept the minutes of the last meeting as typed. The motion was seconded by Josh Jarvis and at roll call all present members voted approval.

Jarvis made a motion to accept the expenditures and the motion was seconded by Beachy. At roll call all present members voted approval.

Mayor Stutzman announced that the Village offer to purchase the parking lot across the street from Lahm's was accepted and he welcomed a motion to move forward with the purchase. Jason Hamsher made a motion to purchase the Lahm's parking lot for the price of \$85,000 and it was seconded by Beachy. At roll call, all present members voted approval.

Village Administrator Specht:

Newton Asphalt was awarded the county paving contract for 2022 and the bid came in at \$310,029. Council requested a list of streets to be paved and Specht said he will get that list. Hamsher made a motion to approve the paving for 2022 and it was seconded by Beachy. At roll call, all members voted approval.

Chief Kevin Kaser:

The speed sign has arrived, and it will be set up within the next few days. The new car cameras and body cams have all been installed and programmed.

Kaser introduced Jeff Stearns and requested that he be hired as a full-time patrolman. Mayor Stutzman appointed Stearns and Beachy made a motion to confirm. The motion was seconded by Hamsher and at roll call all present members voted approval. His start date is June 20, 2022.

Safety Committee chairman Beachy called a 6:15 meeting on June 20, 2022 to discuss the Fire Department.

Hamsher said a resident asked if there was an ordinance regarding Air B&Bs in Sugarcreek. He was told we do not have an ordinance.
