

RECYCLING GUIDELINES

The recyclable materials for Village of Sugarcreek will be collected by Kimble on Wednesdays every-other week by a separate truck. A calendar reflecting recycling days is on the other side.



Please remember to set your refuse and recycling totes at the curb by 6 a.m. Both totes should be between 2-3 feet from the street with lid openings facing the street. The totes should be at least three feet from one another and other objects as such parked cars, mail boxes, trees, or bulky trash items.

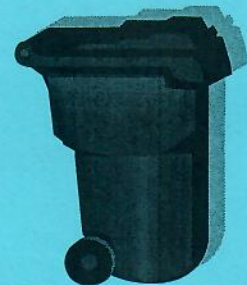
There is no need to bundle your newspapers, cardboard, or any other materials separately. All recyclable materials can be mixed together in your recycle tote.

Please do not use your recycle tote for extra trash. Recycle totes containing refuse will not be emptied and will be tagged to notify the resident of improper use.

Kimble donates to the Village of Sugarcreek-based on the tonnage. Kimble has committed to donating up to \$20.00 per ton for all recyclables generated by the Village of Sugarcreek's curbside recycling program. In addition to donated funds from Kimble, the Village of Sugarcreek will also receive additional grant dollars from the local Solid Waste district based on the total tons recycled.

REFUSE GUIDELINES

On the remaining collection days of the month, Kimble will collect only the contents of the 65-gallon Kimble refuse tote.



On the **first Wednesday of every month**, Kimble will collect **one** bulk refuse item from each house, including but not limited to furniture, appliances, or other items. In lieu of one bulk item, Kimble will collect up to three extra bags of trash or yard waste on bulk pickup day.

Items such as swing sets, carpet, tree limbs, gutter, and down spouts must be cut to **48 inches** or less, and tied into bundles weighing **no more than 50 pounds**, and placed at curbside on bulk pickup day.

Leaves and yard waste will be picked up with the trash, however residents are encouraged to recycle leaves and yard waste at the Village's drop-off Bins located behind Village Hall or next to the Street Dept. Garage on Mill St SW. Christmas trees will also be picked up with the trash.
