

Sugarcreek Village Council had a Regular Council Meeting on Monday April 17, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. in council chambers with Mayor Clayton Weller presiding.

Visitors: Chief Kaser, Bill Theiss, Bev Keller, Barb Limbacher, and Doug Frautschy.

Roll Call: Sam Beachy (came at 7:20), Mick Fanning, Arlen Hostetler, Jeff Schrock, Linda Wilson, and Paul Alderfer.

Minutes: The Mayor asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes. There were none so the minutes stood as typed.

Expenditures: Schrock made a motion to pay list of bills submitted by the Fiscal/Officer, second by Wilson. Vote recorded: Yea 5, Motion carried.

Mayor: Mayor Clayton Weller informed the Council that he had been notified from the Village Township that the Tornado Sirens need a yearly checkup, at a cost of \$380.00. They want to know if the Village would split the cost with them. Hostetler made a motion to get the Sirens checked, by splitting the bill with the Township, second by Alderfer. Vote recorded: Yea 5, Motion carried. Mayor Clayton Weller reported from the Downtown Committee Meeting, that this summer they would like to start having about 3 food trailers in the downtown area, on Fridays. Hostetler made a motion to permit the trailers to come, second by Fanning. Vote recorded: Yea 5, Motion carried. The Mayor then invited anyone to attend the Hospice Dinner at the United Methodist Church, on Friday April 21st, as he will be a server again this year, with his grandson.

Solicitor: Attorney Doug Frautschy said that he would not be at the first meeting in May, as he will be in Cuba.

Fire: Mayor Weller reported to the Council about the garage that will be constructed by the Fire Station, stating that we have had the plans drawn up, but it probably will now not be until sometime next year due to funding.

Police: Chief Kaser said that he would like the Safety Committee to talk about having an Ordinance in place to allow golf carts in the village for special events only. Chief Kaser also said that he needs to get with Attorney Steve Anderson about the State updating a new manual with new codes for the Police Department.

Communication, Public Relation, Refuse: Councilmember Mick Fanning reported that there have been some issues with the first Wednesday large pick-up trash. The Fiscal/Officer will get with Kimble about the contract we now have in place with them, and see what the issues are. Fanning said that he wanted the residents to know that the recyclables bins at the IGA, does not count towards the Village totals.

Streets, Water, & Sewer: Linda Wilson reported from her meeting prior to Council that there a 5 alleys that need names. They did come up with the names, and will have the Solicitor draw up an Ordinance for the new named alleys.

Lands, Buildings, and Sidewalks: Mayor Weller said that from the committee meeting prior to Council that we are going to keep the same rules in place for the Adel Park, and Pavilion behind the Fire Station. Mayor Weller would like for Jan Dodge and Becky Crilow to come up with some rules and regulations for the Grove, and let Council go over them.

Personnel, Economic Development: Jeff Schrock said that he will be cancelling his next committee meeting scheduled for May 8th, until the Administrator and Solicitor have finished all the changes to the Village Handbook.

Hostetler called for a Safety & Insurance committee meeting to be on May 1st at 6:30.
