

July 20, 2020

Sugarcreek Village Council had a regular council meeting on Monday July 20th, 2020 with Mayor Jeff Stutzman presiding.

Visitors: Chief Kevin Kaser, Doug Frautschy, Bev Keller, and Matt Specht.

Roll Call: Clayton Weller (absent), Ron Atkinson, Sam Beachy (absent), Mick Fanning, Jason Hamsher, and Ron Atkinson.

Minutes: Atkinson made a motion to except the minutes as typed by the Fiscal/Officer, second by Miller. Vote recorded: Yea 4, Motion carried.

Expenditures: Fanning made a motion to accept the expenditures, second by Atkinson. Vote recorded: Yea 4, Motion carried.

Street: Village Administrator Matt Specht reported that the underground gas tanks have been removed. The street department would like to install a Generac generator up at the street garage. They got an estimate from Millersburg Electric for \$9,641.00. Atkinson made a motion to purchase the generator, second by Fanning. Vote recorded: Yea 4, Motion carried.

Lot on Square: Specht said that he had gotten two quotes on the parking lot. TW Concrete's quote was \$5,263.00 just to tear out the old surface, and for stamped brick concrete \$63,156.00, and if it were done with just wire and cement it was quoted at \$31,051.00. The second quote was from Gor-Con Construction was \$69,980.00 for stamped brick. It was also noted that the Sugarcreek Businessmen and the downtown committee, are looking into purchasing new benches for the downtown area. Atkinson made a motion to just mill it down and put asphalt the area, second by Miller. Vote recorded: Yea 4, Motion carried.

Flower Lady: Specht said that he had talked to Chief Kevin Miller, and the Fire Department is willing to let her use the Polaris during the morning hours. The Village Solicitor will draw up an Ordinance to allow her to be on the sidewalks and streets with it. It will allow a village vehicle and employee only to use this type of vehicle.

Water: Specht said that he would like to increase Tanner Miller's hourly rate to \$18.26. It is in the pay Ordinance Chief \$29.80

Having nothing further to discuss Atkinson made a motion to adjourn, second by Fanning. Vote recorded: Yea 5, Motion carried.
