Sugarcreek Village Council had a regular council meeting at Village Hall December 4, 2023, with mayor Stutzman presiding.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Sam Beachy, Jason Hamsher, Josh Jarvis, Mick Fanning. Matt Miller and Nathan Wagler were absent.

Sam Beachy made a motion to accept the minutes of the November 20, 2023, meeting and it was seconded by Josh Jarvis. At roll call all present members voted approval.

At 7:05 pm Hamsher made a motion for council to move to executive session to discuss threatened litigation. He invited the mayor, the mayor-elect, the village administrator and the solicitor. Jarvis seconded the motion and at roll call all present members voted approval.

At 7:42 council returned to regular session with no action taken.

Mayor Stutzman: Please keep councilman Miller in our thoughts and prayers after his recent surgery.

Village Administrator, Kaser: The Boston Street Storm Sewer project is complete. There is one change order that needs approved for payment in the amount \$15,682.50. Beachy made a motion to approve the change order and it was seconded by Fanning. At roll call, all present members voted approval.

Crews will be in the village this week to work on the timing of the traffic lights at Shanesville square and at the intersection of St Rt 39 and Factory St.

The new cruiser is ready and may be delivered as soon as 12/5/23.

Councilman Hamsher commented that Light up Sugarcreek was a fun event and congratulated the entire football program for a great season.

Josh Jarvis asked everyone to please keep councilman Miller in their thoughts and prayers, and congratulations to the Garaway football program.

Dee Grossman was present and spoke about the Travel Tusc Tickets for 2023. Open house at the Tuscarawas county convention and visitors bureau is scheduled for Dec 13, 2023 4-6 p.m. She also spoke briefly about the bnbs/air bnbs in Tuscarawas county.


ORDINANCE 23-2375 2nd Reading
