

Regular Council

March 20, 2023

Sugarcreek Village Council had a regular council meeting at Village Hall March 20, 2023, with council pro-tem Jason Hamsher presiding.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Sam Beachy, Mick Fanning, Jason Hamsher, Josh Jarvis, Matt Miller.

Sam Beachy made a motion to accept the minutes of the March 6, 2023, meeting and it was seconded by Matt Miller. At roll call all members voted approval.

Miller made a motion to accept the expenditures and the motion was seconded by Mick Fanning. At roll call all members voted approval.

Jason Hamsher:

Hamsher announced the Village received a letter of resignation from councilman Jim Parson. He read the letter to council. Beachy moved to accept the resignation and it was seconded by Miller. At roll call all members voted approval. Frautschy reminded council they have 30 days to select a replacement for the remainder of the term. If they don't make a selection within 30 days, the Mayor will appoint someone. Council agreed that they will accept resumes, along with a letter of interest/introduction. All received letters/resumes will be reviewed prior to the next council. Information from interested residents should be sent to Village Hall, attn: Fiscal Officer before April 10, 2023.

Village Administrator, Kaser:

A quote was received for work at the Grove on the bandstand. To replace the existing bandstand the estimate is \$28,350.00 which does not include tear down. The estimate to repair the existing bandstand is \$53,000.00. The item was sent to the Parks, recreation committee.

There is some damage at the Putt Memorial and at the fire station that requires a brick laborer. Several quotes will be pursued.

Trees have been removed/trimmed at the Grove. The trees in the village are scheduled for 3/21/23.

The quotes for the proposed green space have not come in yet.

Zurich Street: several quotes were obtained to replace the street with either concrete or asphalt, contractor tear out. The quote to put the new curbs in has not come in yet. The project will be added to the county engineer bid for 2023.

There are some change orders to process for the east end water sewer project.

The audit report for years 2020, 2021 was certified for publication 3/21/23. The audit was completed with no exceptions in all categories. Kaser thanked Fiscal Officer Bowen for the hard work. Frautschy pointed out that it is a good accomplishment. Council was appreciative.

Fiscal Officer: The 2023 appropriations need adjusted. The total will not be affected, just the amounts that go to each fund. Miller moved to reappropriate the 2023 expenses and it was seconded to by Jarvis. At roll call all members voted approval.

Hamsher: Finance Personnel and Audit committee will have a meeting at 6:30 p.m. on April 10, 2023 to review any interest in the open council position. The next regular council meeting will be April 10, 2023.

Fanning commended the excavator company that cleaned out the ditch on St Rt 39 for a job well done. Snow Ban for parking on streets was again discussed. Oasis Church needs a scoop of berm material at Edgemore extension.

Miller: Economic development, parks, and recreation will have a committee meeting at 6:45 pm April 10, 2023.
