

Regular Council

May 15, 2023

Sugarcreek Village Council had a regular council meeting at Village Hall May 15, 2023, with Mayor Jeff Stutzman presiding.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Sam Beachy, Jason Hamsher, Josh Jarvis, Matt Miller, Mick Fanning, Nathan Wagler.

Matt Miller made a motion to accept the minutes of the May 1, 2023, meeting and it was seconded by Sam Beachy. At roll call all members voted approval.

Beachy made a motion to accept the expenditures and the motion was seconded by Hamsher. At roll call all members voted approval.

Mayor Stutzman: The mayor welcomed Nathan Wagler to council.

Village Administrator, Kaser: Kaser and Stutzman met with the health department and submitted 5 homes in the village for review.

The Health department contacted Kaser regarding the lack of dump stations at the grove and there is some paperwork he needs to review before he can report any more information. The street department received 2 quotes from Signal Service company. To add a battery back up to the traffic light at the intersection of St Rt 39 and Dutch Valley Road \$8,590.00. To upgrade the lighting at the same intersection to LED \$2,698.00. Council would like more information about the battery back up and Kaser will bring that information to the next meeting.

Fire Chief Meek: Meek requested that Sheldon Bower be added to the Fire Department Roster. Mayor Stutzman appointed Bower and Beachy made a motion to approve. It was seconded by Jarvis and at roll call all members voted approval.

Police Chief Kaser: Kaser reported that Tyler McKelvey is eligible for promotion to Lieutenant. Beachy made a motion to promote McKelvey. It was seconded by Fanning and at roll call all members voted approval.

Safety committee chairman Sam Beachy reported the committee met prior to council to review the site survey for the proposed fire station. More information is needed before any decisions can be made.

The fire department needs to order an ambulance to replace the back-up unit. He got a quote from PFUND for a 2024 Superliner ambulance. It will not arrive until 2025. The quote is \$373,266.00. Beachy made a motion to order the ambulance and it was seconded by Miller. At roll call all members voted approval. The old unit will be sold as soon as the new one is in service.

Streets, Water, Sewer committee chairman Fanning reported they met prior to council to discuss Pirate's Cove division but he has nothing to announce. The committee will meet June 5<sup>th</sup>, 6:30 p.m. prior to council.

Chip Amicone was present and had a quote from Otto Electric for lighting at the new basketball court in the amount \$9,227.00. He is requesting that the village pay for the lighting. The issue was placed in committee for further discussion.

Economic Development, Parks, & Recreation committee chairman Matt Miller called a committee meeting for June 5, 2023 6:15 p.m. to discuss the lighting.
