Sugarcreek Village Council had a regular council meeting at Village Hall June 17, 2024, with mayor Walt Wilson presiding.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Mick Fanning, Sam Beachy, Nathan Wagler, and Josh Jarvis. Matt Miller and Jason Hamsher were absent.

Sam Beachy made a motion to accept the minutes of the June 3, 2024 meeting as typed and it was seconded by Mick Fanning. At roll call all present members voted approval.

Beachy made a motion to accept the expenditures and it was seconded by Wagler. At roll call all present members voted approval.

Mayor Wilson: The projects at the square are moving forward. Mayor Wilson and Kevin Kaser met with the artist of the cheesemaker statue and some local cheesemakers, and they have come up with a plan for placement of the statue. There was some discussion about possibly adding a pavilion to the area to provide seating and some shade. There will be a brick wall at the back of the property, and a copper cheese kettle is being donated by Chad Schindler of Broad Run Cheesehouse. The statue artist will make plaques listing the donors and sponsors of the statue.

Solicitor Frautschy: Doug expressed thanks to the village, the police department, Lynn Dessecker, and everyone who helped make the Fabulous 50's Fling a successful event.

Village Administrator/Police Chief Kaser: Village ordinance 16-2167 sets the rates for Water tap and connection fees, sewer tap fees, and underground boring. Due to rising costs of materials, those rates will have to be updated. Kaser will deliver the new rates to Solicitor Frautschy to have a new ordinance drawn up for the next meeting.

Councilman Fanning: Economic Development, Parks, & Recreation committee met at 6:30 p.m. to further discuss the possibility of pickleball courts in the village. Fanning made a motion to have the village street department start the excavation of the site for the pickleball courts project. It was seconded by Beachy and at roll call all present members voted approval.

Councilman Beachy: There are some light poles at Winklepleck Grove that are leaning. He asked village administrator Kaser to look at them and see what can be done. He also mentioned that some of the lights are not working.

Councilman Jarvis: Jarvis complimented the Sugarcreek Business Association for the great job putting together the Fabulous 50's Fling June 7 and 8.


