Sugarcreek Village Council had a regular council meeting at Village Hall March 18, 2024, with mayor Walt Wilson presiding.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Jason Hamsher, Mick Fanning, Nathan Wagler, Josh Jarvis, Sam Beachy. Matt Miller was absent.

Sam Beachy made a motion to accept the minutes of the March 18th, 2024, meeting and it was seconded by Nathan Wagler. At roll call all present members voted approval.

Jason Hamsher made a motion to accept the expenditures and it was seconded by Josh Jarvis. At roll call all present members voted approval.

Mayor Wilson: The ramp at the library has been completed and the building is now handicapped accessible.

Village Administrator, Kaser: 2 additional quotes were received for the removal of 14 trees on Maple Street. After discussion about delaying the work until after Swiss Festival, 2024 Hamsher moved to accept the quote from Anywhere Tree Care to do the removal. Beachy seconded the motion and at roll call all present members voted approval.

Kaser presented additional information about the battery back up systems on the traffic lights. Beachy moved to go ahead with one traffic light in 2024 and it was seconded by Fanning. At roll call, all present members voted approval. At this time, it has not been decided whether to do the intersection of St. Rt. 39 and St. Rt. 93, or the light at Factory St. and St. Rt. 39 in 2024.

2 contractors have been contacted about the demolition of the building at 100 N. Broadway St. but neither one has returned a quote.

Police Chief Kaser: Kaser recommends appointing James Long as a patrolman for the village. Mayor Wilson appointed James Long, Sam Beachy moved to confirm the appointment and it was seconded by Jarvis. At roll call all present members voted approval.

K-9 officer Tyler McKelvey started training with the new K-9 dog today, March 18th. Training is scheduled to last 6 weeks. At the conclusion of training, the current K-9 dog will be retired and McKelvey will have the first option to purchase her for a cost of \$1.00 per Ohio Revised Code.

Nathan Wagler announced he will not be present at the April 1, 2024 council meeting.


Resident Russel Neiswander was present and questioned whether anything was done for cars parked facing the wrong direction on the side of the road. Chief Kaser told him they put parking tickets on those cars and they process quite a few. Neiswander also asked how to report a street light that is not working and Kaser advised him to let the police know and they will do the report. He said the light on the corner of 3rd and Oak is out. Kaser will report the light.
